## Pastor's Message:

“From that time Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised.” (Matthew 16:21)

The mood changes quickly for Jesus' disciples. While they are experiencing the joy of Epiphany, the joy of coming to know who Jesus is as the Son of God and Savior of the world, by hearing His teaching and witnessing His miracles, Jesus begins to prepare them for His journey to the suffering and death of the cross.

At first, the disciples do not understand what Jesus is saying. To them, for Jesus to die means defeat and failure in His ministry; they cannot understand how God could be using it for good. The cross remains in some ways a mystery for us as well. We know that Jesus needed to suffer for sins, yet we don't like the idea that following Him may involve

**Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting  
February 3, 2026**

**Present:** Pastor Hojnacki, Ken Fehr, Mark Liefer, Kathy Nagel, Dean Schoenbeck, Brenda Brewer, Roger Liefer, Darrell Salger, Cliff Harms, Michael Koester, Tim Luebkemann, Eric Rohlfing, and Robin Booth.

**Opening:** Chairman Ken Fehr called the meeting to order. Pastor led us in prayer.

Lisa Luebkemann, Youth Group leader, attended the meeting. She noted the poor condition of the chairs in the meeting room and has offered that the Youth Group would assist in purchasing new chairs. She asked for the Council's approval before she proceeded looking at what our options would be. The Council agreed for Lisa to check on what kind of chairs would be a good replacement.

**Principal's Report:** Robin gave a report of upcoming events. They are tossing around the idea of having a dinner auction in the future, not this year. Joyce was involved with COSLHS's auction and suggested maybe we should try it. A Bunco Night is planned for March 5. The Kindergarten Roundup is scheduled for March 15. A Career Day will be held at school on February 27. All is going good at school, the two new students are attending, the bus situation was resolved. There may be another new student in a few weeks.

**Secretary's Report:** The minutes were sent out to the Board. With no changes, a motion was made, seconded and moved to accept the Secretary's Report.

**Treasurer's Report:** Dean reported we received a few donations totally \$1,200.00 in response to the letter Mark Liefer sent out to other congregations asking for support. He also noted that for January our expenses exceeded our income by about \$24,000.00. No extraordinary expenses, just normal small increases, as we all experience. But the income was lower than usual. Dean did pay off \$1,000 off the Dieterich LOC. A motion was made, seconded and moved to accept the treasurer's report.

**Pastor's Report:** There were only 3 Sunday services in January. January 25 service was cancelled due to snow storm. Two days of school were also cancelled from the foot of snow. There were 2 Saturday night services. There were no official acts. There was one transfer out, Heidi Burmester to Hanover Lutheran Church, Cape Girardeau, Mo. There will be 3 adult confirmations, Mandy Wandro, and Billy and Hannah Walter on February 8, and the 3 Wolter children will be baptized on February 28. Ash Wednesday will be February 18. Palm Sunday with confirmation of 3 students will be March 29. Pastor is working on submitting our statistical report for the Synod. This has not been done since before covid. This year the calendar falls unusual with February 28 and March 1 on the same weekend. So, there will be no communion on that weekend. We will have kneeling communion on March 8<sup>th</sup> and standing communion the following weekend, March 14 & 15.

**Elder's Report:** The computer in the church needs to be replaced. It was recommended to take the computer to Sidebar to have them recommend what we need and maybe upgrade our recording capabilities.

**Trustee's Report:** Eric brought up the lawn care for this year. Prime Cutting is willing to do

the job again this year. We have not received his quote yet, but he is doing a great job and was much less than any other quote last year. The key issue was brought up again. Somehow, we are short keys and have lost track of who has keys to the school. If anyone has a key, please notify Joyce in the school office, so that we can have an accounting of where all the keys are. Mark mentioned that the last chair cart from the gym has been sold.

**Redecoration Committee:** The results of the surveys taken at the voters meeting the majority suggested to go with flooring & carpeting as is now and to move the rail and eliminate two pews. This will still need an official vote from the congregation. A special voters meeting will be called in about a month. The painter has been hired and he said it will be about a 3-month process to begin around the end of May. It was decided to go with Wicks Organ to do the painting of the organ pipes. Tim has a sketch of suggestions from the painter. He will put this in the addition for anyone to look at.

The meeting was adjourned. Pastor led us in the Lord’s Prayer.





**Editor's Note:**


Trinity Lutheran School will be sending home report cards on March 13. More memories!
