#### Message from Pastor Hojnacki:

"While He blessed them, He parted from them and was carried up into heaven." (Luke 24:51)

The book of Acts tells us the Ascension took place 40 days after Jesus' resurrection. Each year, we gather for a special worship service 40 days after Easter, which always falls on a Thursday (this year, May 9). Just as the apostles returned to the temple rejoicing and praising God, so also we gather in the house of God to sing His praise for Jesus' glorious Ascension into heaven.

The Ascension of Jesus is part of His exaltation, part of His victory, having accomplished the salvation of the world by His death and resurrection. His saving work complete, He returns to the heavenly realm from which He came, not absent from His Church on earth but ruling over all creation for our good. Jesus also prepares His apostles for the impending coming of the Holy Spirit, who will inspire them to proclaim the good news of eternal life and salvation through Jesus into all the world. Essentially, the Ascension begins

#### Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting April 2, 2024

**Present:** Pastor Hojnacki, Tim Luebkemann, Mark Liefer, Kathy Nagel, Dean Schoenbeck, Brenda Brewer, Byron Burmester, Marvin Stellhorn, Roger Liefer, Darrell Salger, and Lori Woods.

**Opening:** Chairman Tim Luebkemann called the meeting to order. Pastor led us in prayer.

**Secretary's Report:** The minutes from last month's meeting were sent out to all the Board. With no changes or corrections, a motion was made, seconded, and moved to accept the secretary report.

**Treasurer's Report:** Dean presented the treasurer's report. He noted that the Fish Fry was successful with a profit of approximately \$6300. The cost of \$4100 for the sewer/water line repairs at school has been paid, and the down payment of \$2000 was made for the shower upgrade in the parsonage. He also noted that the monthly income is running less than our expenses. There was discussion on the \$65,000 that was moved out of a brokerage account last month and what to do with it. It was felt to leave half of it in the checking account to cover the monthly deficit. A motion was made to move the other half to a 3-month CD paying 4.6% interest at Dieterich Bank. Motion carried. Dean brought up the new Illinois Paid Leave for All Workers Act Notice (PLAWAN) that went into effect January 1. There still are a lot of unanswered questions on how this should work. It was decided to contact the Southern Illinois District Office to see if we can get information from them on how this will affect churches and schools. This should only affect our part-time workers, not Pastor or the full-time teachers.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor reported that there were 13 services in April. Attendance was lower this Easter than other years with 130 attending each service on Easter morning. In official acts, there was the funeral for Mason Kinney on March 9, which Pastor Hojnacki and Pastor Nebel did together at St John's, Red Bud. One Baptism, Willow Heck, daughter of Ryan and Meghan Heck on March 23. On the 24<sup>th</sup>, 4 eighth graders were confirmed: Khloe DuFrenne, Carter Lange, Hailey Voss, and James Wandro. Pastor started a new adult confirmation class with 4 candidates along with family members attending. Upcoming is Ascension on May 9<sup>th</sup>, our annual Prairie Picnic on May 19<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation on May 21.

**Elder's Report:** They are working with Pastor on trying to get church attendance up. Also, they are still looking for someone to volunteer to edit the church services and get the copies to WHCO for broadcast on the following Sunday.

**School Board Report:** Lori reported that spotlights were purchased for the flag and asked Tim to install them. They are busy working on the accreditation. The end of the school year is coming up. On May 13 will be the Pre-K "Bridging". Rather than a graduation, they are going over the bridge to kindergarten! The school board is planning a ball tournament after the school play at the picnic. Also in regards to the picnic it was decided to have a grill set up outside after the play for burgers. Since it is Armistice weekend, some sort of military recognition is also being planned.

#### Council:

**Miscellaneous:** We are again thinking ahead to the next school year. Robin Booth has agreed to again teach Kindergarten. However, with the extra responsibility's she is asking for an increase in pay. She is currently serving as Principal, school secretary and kindergarten teacher. It was discussed and the Council feels that an increase in pay would be less than having to find another person to fill either of those positions. This will have to be voted on by the congregation, so a special voter's meeting is being planned for April 21<sup>st</sup>.

The meeting was adjourned. Pastor led us in the Lord's Prayer.

> Special Voters Meeting April 21, 2024

A special voter's meeting was called to order following the April 21 church service. 53 voting members were in attendance.

For the 2024-2025 school year, Dr. Robin Booth has agreed to again take on the responsibilities of the school Principal, secretary, and kindergarten teacher. Since she is holding 3 positions, she is asking for an annual raise of \$12,000. After a brief discussion, a motion was made to add \$12,000 to her annual salary of \$58,434 (that was voted on at the annual meeting in January) for the school year beginning August 2024. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned.

. . . .

The large painting behind the altar at church is a depiction of the Ascension. Jesus has His hands raised in blessing as He is ascending. Only one foot is visible in the painting, as Jesus is already lifting off the ground; the ground is not seen in the painting. The other foot, one must imagine, is obscured by Jesus' robes as it is lifted up behind Him, as if leaping off the ground. The blue sky in the background is mixed with white clouds and the yellow-orange of sunlight (or perhaps indicating the light of the glory of the risen Jesus). Every time we come into the house of God, we see the image of the risen and ascended Jesus blessing us as we worship in His presence.
